

# Towel warmers

*A heated towel rail will keep your bathroom warm and the towels dry*



## What to consider

- The choice of finishes includes chrome, antique gold, polished brass, nickel and white.
- Floor-standing towel rails and those with widely spaced bars will take larger towels.
- A narrow ladder rail or a wall-mounted rail fitted over the foot of the bath saves space.
- Most towel warmers run off your central heating system; dual fuel rails have an electric option to work when the central heating is turned off; and electric rails can be switched on and off independently.
- If you want a towel warmer to heat the room, check that its heat output is sufficient.



**1 Cambridge chrome towel rail** with fold down shelf, H1,135mm and available in three widths: 350mm, £1,013.23; 500mm, £1,132.51; 800mm, £1,279.41, The Radiator Company.  
**2 Combined basin stand and towel warmer** – this brass Victorian classic heated towel rail in chrome or Incalux gold finish is £1,009.86, including W635mm Victorian basin, BC Sanitan.  
**3 Alara polished stainless steel ladder rail** comes in 11 sizes from W350mm x H720mm, £230.30, MHS.  
**4 Karnak square section stainless steel towel warmer** with evenly spaced rails comes in white chrome and polished or matt stainless steel, W500mm x H1,000mm, £924; W500mm x H1,700mm, £1,103, Aeon.  
**5 LG0 floor-standing brass towel warmer** in chrome finish, W575mm x D262mm x H925mm, £897, the Archive Collection by Vogue.  
**6 Heated towel radiator** with brass frame in chrome, silver nickel and antique gold with white cast-metal column radiator, W495mm x H960mm, £790; W675mm x H960mm, £890, Catchpole & Rye. ↪
